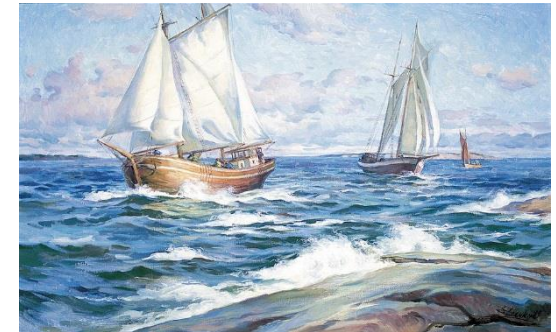

Similes and metaphors. Reading and writing poems about the sea.</p> <p><u>The Storm Whale</u> Reading comprehension - Why didn't Noi take the whale back to the sea?</p> <p><u>The Secret of Black Rock</u> Reading/writing about animals that live at sea. Why must we look after our oceans?</p> <p><u>The Pirates Next Door</u> Writing persuasive letters to the pirates convincing them we would be great pirates!</p>	<p>Phonics Phase 3</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Handwriting.</li> <li>• Rhyming words.</li> <li>• Segmenting the sounds in simple words and blending them together.</li> <li>• Using clearly identifiable letters to communicate meaning, representing some sounds correctly and in sequence.</li> <li>• Writing own name and other things such as labels, captions.</li> <li>• Writing short sentences in meaningful contexts.</li> </ul>	<p>Phonics Phase 5</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Handwriting families.</li> <li>• Sequencing sentences to form short narratives.</li> <li>• Using the spelling rule for adding -s or -es.</li> <li>• Reading and writing words with contractions (e.g. I'm, I'll, we'll).</li> <li>• Writing extended sentences using 'and'.</li> <li>• Using a range of sentence openers.</li> <li>• Spelling common high frequency words.</li> <li>• Punctuating sentences with . ? or !</li> <li>• Compound words (e.g. football, farmyard)</li> </ul>

<b>Mathematics</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Counting forwards and backwards, starting at any number.</li> <li>Addition and Subtraction.</li> <li>Representing numbers using pictorial representations, including the number line.</li> <li>Measuring lengths and height.</li> <li>Identifying half of an amount, object or shape (Yr 1 only - identifying a quarter).</li> <li>2D and 3D shapes.</li> <li>Following directions - Treasure hunt!</li> </ul>	<b>Numbers to 100</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Addition and subtraction fact families.</li> <li>Missing number addition and subtraction.</li> <li>Counting to 2s, 5s and 10s.</li> <li>Reading and writing numbers as words (to 20).</li> <li>Comparing, describing and solving practical problems for length and height.</li> </ul>	<b>Numbers to 20</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Recording using marks they can explain and interpret.</li> <li>Comparing amounts using greater than, less than and equal to.</li> <li>Reading and ordering numerals.</li> <li>One more and one less.</li> <li>Ordering objects by length and height.</li> </ul>
<b>Science</b>	Scientific enquiry (Everyday Materials) - Floating and Sinking. Animal - Identifying common sea creatures.
