



Home Learning

All children are expected to complete activities at home in order to reinforce and consolidate their learning.

Home learning is set regularly during the week and can take the form of reading, spelling, multiplication tables, mental maths or activities linked to a classroom focus. Although home learning is set on a regular basis, we try to strike a balance so that children also have time to participate in their leisure activities.

Throughout the year we aim to organise events at which parents can find out more about the curriculum, and ways in which you can help your child at home.

Langley Fitzurse School also invites parents and/or guardians to sign our home school agreement. This is another way of developing the home-school links we believe to be so important.
