



Admissions

Children are admitted into the school in the September following their fourth birthday. Where appropriate, individual induction plans may be made through consultation with parents.

We have links with a number of local playgroups and nurseries and children start school with a wide range of different experiences.

Before they are due to start, the children take part in an induction programme which will start in July and continue in September. We will also invite you to an induction meeting with our Early Years teacher and the Headteacher. At that meeting we will explain the ways in which we will settle your child into school and what you can do to help. This is a partnership that we hope to foster throughout their school life at Langley Fitzurse.

Prospective parents are very welcome to visit the school to look round. Please contact us to make an appointment.

Our children come from both the village and further afield. The exact boundaries of our designated area can be seen on a map held in the school office. Priority is given to those children living within this area, and then to those with siblings already attending school. Following that places are given to children depending on

the distance from school to their home. This is in line with county admissions criteria.

Transition through school

We currently have 99 pupils, and these are divided into 4 classes. Usually there are no more than two year groups in a class, although this may vary when the number of pupils in certain year groups is outside of the natural range, or when it is felt to be appropriate to include additional children with particular learning needs.

If we need to split year groups, this will be based primarily on academic progress in KS2 and age in KS1, though individual learning needs are also taken into consideration.
