Medicines in School



We prefer that no medication is be given to any pupil during the school day. Very few medications need to be taken during normal school hours, and in most cases three times a day can be given before school, after school and at night. We will of course,

however, administer medicine if the dosage is different. Langley Fitzurse has a policy statement regarding this matter. Please see the school's website for more details.

At the age of 11, most children transfer to secondary school in Chippenham. Children are mostly admitted to Hardenhuish, Sheldon or Abbeyfield schools depending on parental choice. We have excellent liaison with all three schools and have regular contact. The children are
