Communication and Language

- **Listening:** Knowing that they need to be quiet and concentrate when listening. Listening to a whole story from beginning to end. Showing interest in non-fiction books linked to topic or theme.

This is an overview of some of the subject matter that we will be learning about this term.

Physical Development

- © **Fine Motor**: Using one-handed tools and equipment. Beginning to show anticlockwise movements and retrace vertical lines. Beginning to form recognisable letters.
- © **Gross Motor:** Balance bikes, dancing to Nursery Rhymes, jumping from apparatus, making shapes and landing safely.

Expressive Art and Design

- Textiles: Decorate a piece of fabric.
- © **Printmaking:** Develop simple patterns by using objects. © **Sculpture**: Impress and apply simple decoration.
- © Safely use and explore a variety of materials, tools and techniques. Experiment with colour, design, texture, form and function. Talk about the differences between materials and changes they notice using a wide vocabulary.

Literacy Word Reading: Identifying rhymes. Read individual letters by saying the sounds for them. Blending sounds into words. Read simple words and simple sentences.

- Writing: Use their phonics knowledge to write words in ways that match their spoken sounds. Start to orally rehearse sentences before writing simple sentences which can be read by themselves and sometimes by others.
- © **Comprehension:** Using vocabulary and events from stories in their play.
- © **Computing:** dictate a short sentence by recording their voice over a picture.
