Up, Up and away Y1/2, Term 1 2023 -2024


This is an overview of our learning this term.

English:

We will be using books linked to our topic of space, such as:

The way home for Wolf by Rachel Bright and Jim Field, Astro Girl by Ken Wilson-Max, Sidney, Stella and the moon by Emma Yarlett and Toys in space by Mini Grey. This term we will focus on basic sentence structures whilst extending our vocabulary.

In addition we will write some poetry about 'If I was an astronaut ...'



Art:

'In the dark of night' will inspire our learning in art, taken from Van Gogh's 'Starry Night'.

DT:

We will create rockets using scrap materials and other space-related items.

Maths:

Y1: Numbers to 10, : Number bonds, Addition within 10, Subtraction within 10 and positions.

Y2: Numbers to 100, Addition and subtraction and multiplication of 2, 5, 10.



Field and Forest:

We will be completing more wild challenges as we work towards our silver award.



Science - My body

We will be learning to explore the parts of our bodies we use for different activities. We will learn about the five senses of touch, smell, taste and sound, and in particular the sense of sight.



RE: Belonging

We will explore what it means to belong.

RHE:

We will follow SCARF planning and learn about 'Me and my relationships'.

History – Geography:

We will be learning about the moon and it's charcteristics. Find out about the first man in space, understand what occurred and why it was a landmark event. Understand what was needed in order to help a man survive in space. Find out about the first moon landing, who was involved and what happened. Understand that there is no atmosphere on the moon.
