The children showed great enthusiasm when learning about Florence Nightingale and they wrote stories set in Florence's time.

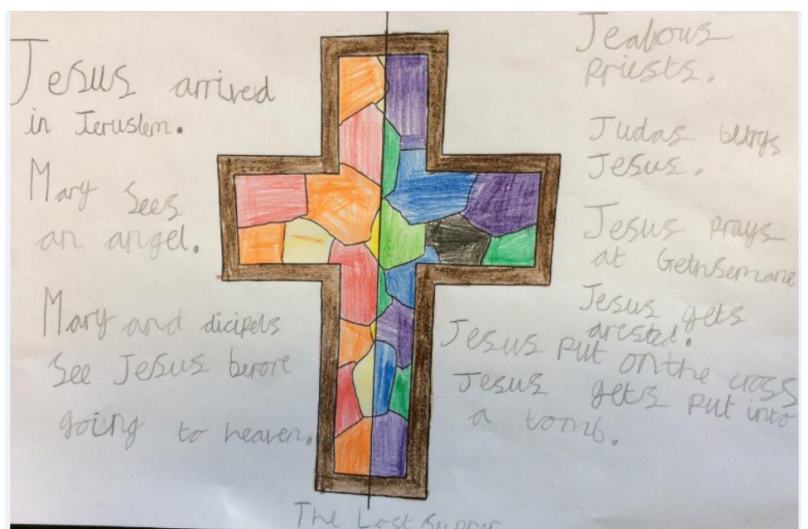
In geography we explored our local area; another time we collected items in nature for our art creation in the style of Andy Goldsworthy.



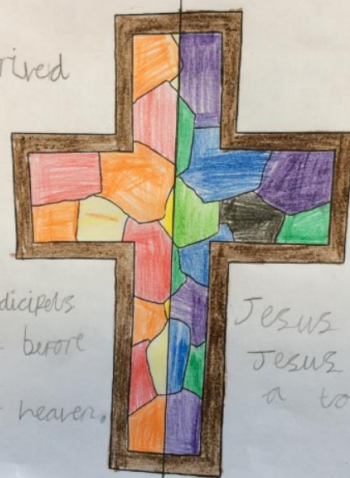
