It has been a busy start to the academic year! In our topic, we have been learning about Amelia Earhart an American aviation pioneer who became the first woman to fly solo across the Atlantic Ocean. She set numerous aviation records and became a global cultural icon, known for her advocacy for women's rights and for promoting commercial air travel. Sadly, her life ended in mystery when she disappeared over

the Pacific Ocean in 1937 while attempting to fly around the world.

We have been looking at illustrations by Quentin Blake, as in English we read 'James and The Giant Peach'. We became artists and did drawings in the style of Quentin Blake; as you can see, we have some wonderful artists in our Pegasus Class.

Both Year 2 and Year 3 will be working on multiplication in their Maths lessons, so please encourage them to practice their times tables on Times Table Rockstars. The log in is the same as

their Numbots log ins. You will need to download the Times Table Rockstars app. Please continue using Numbots, playing little and often (we suggest a minimum of 2x per week for 10-15 minutes) will significantly improve your child's recall and understanding of number bonds, addition and subtraction facts, which are a critical foundation in Maths.
