We have had another busy term with lots of fun experiences for Pegasus. We went to the We The Curious Museum and had our Aztecs day on Tuesday, where we dressed

up as Aztecs and welcomed our parents to see our work. The children enjoyed a chocolate fountain (just look at those choccy faces), making chinampas (floating gardens), building Aztec temples and creating headdresses. The culmination was a solemn 'Fire Celebration' in which the children participated in an exemplary way.

In science, we have been looking at electricity and creating circuits. The children made a simple circuit, then were challenged to add in the switch. They had to think about how to connect it while maintaining an electrical circuit. We then applied our learning on electricity for our Christmas tree ornaments. The Children have made a Rudolph Christmas tree decoration with the nose lighting up. **WARNING:** Choking hazard, the battery used is a button battery and the bulb is a small LED light.

The children have continued to practise their Maths skills, focusing on multiplication and division.

In English, we linked our writing to our topic work and created beautiful non-chronological reports about the Aztecs. Our narrative story was set in Tenochtitlan and the children tried hard to include aspects of what they had learned into their stories.
