This is an overview of some of the subject matter that we will be learning about this term.

English:

- We will be reading Skygazing (by Anna Claybourne) as our topic on Space We will be looking at subheadings, generating questions and how to answer them by reading research. The story of Flight Jakob Whitfield will let us use persuasion in our writing.
- The Last Bear by Hannah Gold will be our Guided Reading book

Humanities:

 In Geography we will learn to read and use maps, atlases and digital maps.
 Recognising both physical and human features and becoming able to locate a variety of places. The children will create their own maps, marking significant features with appropriate grid references

PSHE:

 Me and My Relationships will look at how we keep ourselves safe, make decisions, respecting and learning to tolerant other people's ideas. We will look at different scenarios and have a whole class discussion justifying our opinions

Maths:

Year 3

- Place value to 1000
- Addition facts

Year 4

- Place value to 10000
- To round, compare and order
- Finding patterns
- Adding and subtracting methods with exchanging and renaming
- Solving problems and puzzles

Art/DT:

PE:

- Netball we will look at tactics and rules to play the game. Passing, footwork and shooting
- Dance we will be looking at dances from around the world we will choreograph actions. Learn technical language, use mirroring and changing the level of our body

- Create scenes using selected shapes and images – Explore changing 2D pictures into 3D settings of different habitats

Music/Singing:

- Charanga theme How does music bring us together?: studying musical structures
- Singing, glockenspiel playing, improvisation, listening skills, elements of music, question and answer rhythms

Science:

 Looking at liquid, gas and solid State of Matter. What happens when they become hot and what causes evaporation

French:

- Year 3 will be introduce to French words and expressions. The children will be able to introduce themselves and have a wider appreciation for the country/countries where the foreign language is spoken.
