This is an overview of some of the subject matter that we will be learning about this term.

English:

- Continue Sounds Write phonics and spelling programme
- Continue reading The Last Bear for Guided Reading
- We will be reading about Anglo Saxons and using:
- persuasive language
- Kennings
- writing to inform
- narrative

Humanities:

 In History we are learning about Anglo Saxons. We will be looking at how they invaded and there unique alphabet. Understanding village life and culture and exploring the artefacts.

PSHE:

Rights and Respect
We will be learning how to stay safe in numbers. What are our rights are and what expenses mean.

Maths:

Y3

Art/DT:

- We will research Anglo Saxons shields and coil-ing clay pots
- We will recreate our own coil-ing clay pots

PE:

- Yoga we will learn exercises to control breathing, we will perform movement by isolating body parts so our movements are controlled.
- Rounders we will be developing our throwing and catching skills. Learning how to field, striking the ball and tactics to stop the opposition from scoring.

Music/Singing:

RE:

- Exploring the meaning of baptism and Trinity
- We will be looking at the big question: 'What is the Trinity?'
- Learn how Christians show their beliefs about God the Trinity in worship.

Science:

 Magnets and forces we will be looking at push and pull force and what happens when we change the surface.

French:

- Year 3 will be able to recognise, recall, remember and spell up to 10 animals. Building their first sentences with verbs.
- Year 4 will perform a short roleplay in a French tea room. This will help consolidate much of the grammar covered in our Early Learning teaching type (nouns, gender, determiners and plurality).
