English:

- Continue Sounds Write phonics and spelling programme
- Start reading our new guided reading book, The Firework- Maker's Daughter.
- We will write a narrative from the book The boy Who Grew Dragons.
- Suffix ending 'ed' and learning the 4 different rules needed, when writing an 'ed' word.

Maths:

Y3

- Multiplying by 2-digit numbers
- Multiplying with renaming
- Dividing with renaming
- Solving word problems

Y4

- Multiplying by 6, 7, 9, 11 & 12
- Dividing by 6, 7, 9, 11 & 12
- Dividing with renaming
- Solving word problems

Humanities:

 In History we are learning about Vikings. We are drawing on prior learning from last term when we looked at Anglo-Saxons and comparing

Art/DT:

- Looking at Viking artwork and exploring patterns.
- The children will be using a range of materials to re-create their own Viking pattern.

PE:

- Swimming the children will be attending the Olympaid for their lessons.
- Football we will be learning how to pass and control the ball. How and why we use long pass instead of dribbling through the opposition, as well as movement off the ball to influence play.
