It has been a busy start to the academic year! We visited Bristol Museum and learnt more about the Ancient Greeks. We explored actual pottery from that time period and learnt that broken pieces found by archaeologists are called "sherds." After the workshop, we further explored the museum and discovered an area dedicated to the Ancient Egyptians, which will be our topic for Term 3. We also participated in a Guinness World Record attempt for the largest poetry lesson; more information on whether we have broken the record will be shared in November.
