Overview of learning for Spring 1, 2019 The Iron Age

Literacy	We start off this term with writing adventure stories. Linked
	to our topic we will also do non-fiction writing as we explore
	the Iron Age. Throughout the term we will continue to learn
	grammatical features, such as nouns, verbs, adjectives,
	conjunctions, plurals, etc; explore different spelling patterns,
	prefixes and suffixes, and extend our punctuation skills from
	basics sentence structures (Capital letters and full stops) to
	using commas in lists, exclamation marks and question marks,
	as well as speech marks.
Maths	This term we will build on children's learning of the 2x, 5x and
	10x table (Y2) to learning other time tables (Y3: $3x$ , $4x$ , $8x$ ) and
	applying this knowledge in a variety of problem solving. We
	will build on our knowledge of fractions of numbers and
	shapes. We will continue to count, partition and calculate, by
	using different strategies. We will work with 3D solids as well
	as 2D shapes and further our understanding of reflective
	symmetry.
Science	We will learn about rocks and the internal structure of the
Schence	earth and how volcanoes come about. We will investigate and
	compare different types of rock and learn about the process of
	fossilisation.
Computing	Computing this term will primarily support our topic work by

	will support Literacy and Numeracy by using interactive
	learning resources.
History	In History we will study the Iron Age and how people lived. We
	will look at hillforts and learn about Queen Boudicca and the
	Celts.
Geography	This will focus on areas of the UK which were important
	during the Iron Age
RE	This term will focus on inspirational people and the qualities
	needed to be an inspirational person.
PE	On Wednesday afternoon the children will be taught PE by our
	Sports Coach, focusing on Multi-skills. On Thursday, Y3 will
	go swimming.
Music	Music will explore timbre, tempo and dynamics. Children will
	have opportunity to play percussion instruments and learn the
	basics of musical notation.
DT	We will create models Iron Age roundhouses. There will be
	opportunity to create Iron Age jewellery. We also will link
	our science topic by creating some fossils.
Art	Art will focus on observational drawing of artefacts from the
	Iron Age, as well as our science topic.
