	Review/monitor your School Development Plan
	Review your <b>Child Protection Action Plan</b> with your Head, developed following your CP audit undertaken in the Autumn
	Receive final confirmation of data (ASP, IDSR, FFT etc.) and review

## If appropriate

 Plan the induction of any new governors and encourage them to book onto a School Governance Service 'New Governor' (induction training) day or access on-line training free of charge as part of their subscription package.
