Foundation Governor Vacancies

What is a foundation governor?

The LFSSQ Federation is quite unique in that it is a federation of a Church of England and Community School.

Whilst a Foundation Governor role has a particular responsibility to preserve and develop the Christian character at Langley Fitzurse, the role is an integral part of the Governing Body that oversees the development of both schools. Foundation Governors have an equal share of the responsibility for things such as: supporting the school; developing the school improvement plan; making budgetary decisions; holding the headteacher to account; and monitoring the implementation of school policies.

Fire Evacuation

Health and safety is always a key part of the school's day to day working. It is so important that our procedures are embedded and effective, and that children and staff follow these practices as part of normal behaviours.

Today we held a routine Fire Drill/ Evacuation. These are held every term, and now that all the children are back in school together, we took the opportunity to remember and practice what to do if the fire alarms goes off.

The whole school evacuated the building in less that two minutes in a calm and orderly way. Those children who weren't in class at the time of the drill i.e. violin lessons or visiting the toilet, remembered to leave by the front door and not return to their own classes.

All classes lined up quickly and quietly outside the school grounds, where staff were able complete an effective role call.

A very well done to all our children for such sensible and safe behaviours.
