Curriculum Map

This is an overview of some of the subject matter that we will be learning about this term.

English:

- Scripts and performing with expression.
- Building on Y5/6 punctuation and grammar – comma splices, clause structures and formality.
- Greek myths and legends.
- Non-fiction reading comprehensions.
- Writing to persuade.
- Spelling using our phonics knowledge.

Humanities (Geography/History):

- Using digital mapping to local countries and describe features of Greece.
- Greek life and achievements and their influence on the modern world.
- Thinking like historians – how can we use sources to build our understanding of a time?

Music:

Learning to sing and perform our songs for production.

Maths:

- Adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing fractions and decimals.
- Converting between improper fractions and mixed numbers.
- Finding fractions and percentages of amounts. (ie. $\frac{3}{4}$ of 20)
- Fraction, decimal and percentage equivalence. (ie. $20\% = 0.2 = \frac{1}{5}$)
- Algebra (Y6s).
- Reading and interpreting line graphs, tables and timetables.

Art/DT:

- Cooking and nutrition – making Greek salads and tasting Greek food.
- Designing and making clay pots.

Y6s – Getting secondary ready!
