Sports Day

Weather permitting, we will be holding Sports Day on Friday 2nd July. This will take place on the Kington Langley Playing Fields, starting at approx. 9.30am. The updated guidance from last week is as follows:

- * Sports Days may go ahead, in line with the rest of the system of controls.
- * Pupils must remain in their bubbles.
- * Sports equipment should be regularly cleaned throughout the event.
- * Spectators must adhere to current social distancing requirements.
- * Where events take place outdoors, spectators can gather in separate groups of up to 30 – the legal gathering limit.
- * Multiple groups of 30 are permitted.

This means that we can invite parents from all classes to our Sports Day. Parents must remain in ‘class parent zones’ and maintain social distancing. In order to accommodate numbers, we ask that you book a space within your child’s class’s ‘parent zone’. Initially we will offer 1 space to each family, but if there are spare places, we will open this up to additional family members on a first come first served basis next week. Watch out for a Parent-Mail form later this week.

Children will need to wear sports kit on Friday 2nd June., **plus a tee shirt that is predominantly in their house colour—red, green, blue or yellow.**

They will also need a water bottle, sun hat and have applied sun cream prior to coming to school.
