We continued by learning about different rainforest animals in order to write an information text about them. Having learned about features of an information text we were able to apply this to our chosen animal. Our final product was to make this into a 'leaf-booklet'; the children love to sit under our reading tree and share their own booklet or a different book with their friends!

For our narrative writing we created rainforest settings inside a shoebox. This has helped us to act out and practise our stories before writing them down.

All our learning about animals made a suitable link to our science topic where we explored different categories of animals.



Our value of 'Truthfulness' and our RE theme of 'Believing' stimulated some really interesting discussions in class and I have been very impressed when children remembered to make a good choice and tell the truth.

Y1 have worked hard on consolidating place value in order to build a solid foundation for working with bigger numbers, as well as measuring objects in standard and non-standard units of measurements.

Y2 have expanded their measuring skills to measuring mass, temperature and length, whilst continuing to practice multiplication and division for 2x, 5x and 10x tables.



During Children Mental Health Week we enjoyed doing yoga every day and learning strategies to help us feeling calm. We also re-introduced our class-worry box where children can post their worries and concerns.
