This is an overview of some of the subject matter that we will be learning about this term.

English:

This term we will link a lot of our writing to the topic of dinosaur. After some exploration of different dinosaurs, we will use this information to recap on features of non-chronological reports and create our own.

We then will look at narratives and will use stories such as 'If I had a dinosaur' and 'Dinosaurs in my school' to plan and write our own story.

Additionally, we will write some dinosaur poetry. Throughout the term we will practise spellings and aspects of grammar and punctuation.



Maths:

Y1: Fractions of shapes, numbers up to 100, recognising money (coins and notes), as well as reading the time (to the hour) and terminology connected to time

Y2: 2D and 3D shapes, fractions of shapes and numbers, as well as time (reading time to quarters of an hour, some to 5 min intervals) and terminology connected to time, as well as duration of events. SATs practice and test.

Science – Everyday materials:

Explore different types of material and distinguish between the object and the material it is made of, describe properties, compare and group different materials. Y2: look at the suitability of different materials for different purposes and how they can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching

Computing:

Data collection – create a Venn and Carroll diagram
Use editing skills such as changing font, colour, size

Art/DT:

Create a paperplate dinosaur using printing techniques for exploring their skin patterns. Create our own fossils

Dippy the Diplodocus, whilst exploring classical pieces by Saint-Saens (Fossils) and Prokofiev, and accompany some dinosaur songs with tuned and untuned instruments
