

Superheroes in History Y1/2, Autumn 2 2022/23

This is an overview of some of the subject matter that we will be learning about this term.

English:

This term children will continue to develop their writing skills by learning about inspirational people in history, such as Guy Fawkes, Rosa Parks and Emily Davison and write recounts about their lives. Learning about fire safety and making edible sparklers will provide opportunity for writing instruction texts. Bonfire Night will be perfect for some more poetry!

Remembrance Day and Anti-Bullying week will provide further writing opportunities.

Children will learn about the Christmas story and by rehearsing our Nativity Play, will be learning about playscripts.

Art:

We will develop our drawing skills by drawing portraits of our 'Superheroes in History' and use decorative techniques when making Christmas cards and craft activities. Y1 will focus on creating darker and lighter tones in painting by using black and white, whilst Y2 will explore this without the use of black and white.
